BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 21st day of February, A.D. 2018 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in Regular session at 1:00 PM with **KATHYRN G. WISEMAN**, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: **OSCAR GARCIA**, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, **CRAIG BAILEY**, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, and **JIMMIE LONG**, Commissioner Precinct No. 3. **JOHN H. CLINE**, Commissioner Precinct No. 4 was absent.

The meeting was called to order @1:09 p.m.

Court moved into Executive/Closed session @ 1:10 p.m.

Court reconvened into Regular session @ 1:24 p.m. and no action was taken as a result of the Executive/Closed session.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve paying the Invoices as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Purchase Requests as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor, with the addition of a request from Sheriff Stan Parker to switch internet service at his location from Suddenlink @ \$240 per month to Westex @ \$180 per month. This change will require a 2 year obligation. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

There are no Budget Amendments on this date.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the Auditor's Monthly Report as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the Payroll as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. Judge Kathryn Wiseman pointed out that she has had to pay County employees to interpret due to the fact that she has not been able to get anyone through the interpreter line in a timely manner. That cost is included in the Payroll. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve Personnel considerations as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, stated the Executive/Closed session he requested will have to be postponed due to Joshua Hamby, County Attorney, not being available.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve changing the Signature Authority and a new permit form for Pipeline Crossings as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator. The change will make Brian Klinksiek the Signature Authority rather than Judge Kathryn Wiseman. The form will be the same except for the name of the Signature Authority. Mr. Klinksiek will make reports to the Commissioners Court on those Pipeline Crossings being approved. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve 19 Pipeline Crossings as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to amend the original motion making Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, the Signature Authority on Pipeline Crossings to include that they "must meet the specs" in order for him to approve. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the County Clerk's Monthly Report for January 2018 as presented by Brent Zitterkopf, County Clerk. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Vince Viaille, Managing Director of Specialize Public Finance, Inc. presented the Sale Overview – Series 2018 Tax Notes.
