



CLINE**, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

Budget workshop held on this date.

Discussion was on tax appraisal values.

Commissioner Cline will call County Trapper and notify him that his raise request will not be granted.

Judge Wiseman informed the court that attorney ad-litem fees will increase to \$450 effective July 10, 2017.

Court agreed to set up an emergency purchasing plan for purchases needed in emergency situations. Each commissioner will have departments and the Auditor will contact them for an okay.

Auditor reminded court that they will be selecting the outside Auditor at the next meeting.


Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, reported to court that a private citizen was inquiring on costs to lay a permanent saltwater line down a County Right of Way.
