BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 28th day of December, A.D. 2015 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in regular session at 5:30 PM with KATHYRN G. WISEMAN, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: OSCAR GARCIA, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, CRAIG BAILEY, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, JIMMIE LONG, Commissioner Precinct No. 3 and JOHN H. CLINE, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

Judge Wiseman asked for registered Citizens to speak at this time. Clem Jones reported that he has been contacted by letter from CGGG Corp to put data collectors on his property and he was curious. Commissioner Long reported that they were a legitimate company.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Cline to allow County Judge, Kathryn G. Wiseman permission to sign the Seismic Permit and the monies paid will be split between Howard County and Howard County Industrial Board. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Department Head recommendations as presented by Teresa Thomas, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the bills as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor, minus the \$111,900.00 bill to Tyler Technologies until the maintenance issues are worked out. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the following purchase requests as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor: Library – 55 books from Possum Grape @ \$981.45, 92 Books from Possum Grape @ \$1649.00 and Consortium Fee for E- Book start up from Overdive @ \$6000.00; County Engineer – used

AM/FM Radio @ \$50.00, 1 Motor Grader from Warren Cat @ \$117,955.00, 6000 gallons Emulsion from Heartland @\$11,000.00 and 300 tons Road Base from Tubb Quarry @ \$20,000.00. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the Resolution to join and participate in the PACE Purchasing Cooperative as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. There is no cost to the County. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to accept the bid for the Shoulder Widening Volcan materials under the Road Grant. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to postpone the opening of the Seal Coating Bids until January 8, 2016 due to the holidays. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long seconded by Commissioner Garcia to table the motion from Hollis McCright, Librarian to increase the part time employee's hours to 30 until the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in January. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.
