BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 23rd day of February, A.D. 2015 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in regular session at 10:00 AM with KATHYRN G. WISEMAN, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: OSCAR GARCIA, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, CRAIG BAILEY, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, JIMMIE LONG, Commissioner Precinct No. 3 and JOHN H. CLINE, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to table the Resolution to rename a portion of I-20 East in memory of fallen State Troopers Jimmy Parks and Troy Hogue to study the funding part of this issue. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to table verifying the statement on the Lone Star Railroad Inc. on the Industrial Park until the Court can verify a few things. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Commissioner Cline and Commissioner Long presented their certificates of Completion for their 2014 hours.

Court went into Executive Session at 10:30AM.

Court reconvened into Open Session at 10:45 AM.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the bills with the total being \$342,679.40. A vote was taken and the following members of the Court voted "AYES": Commissioner Garcia, Commissioner Bailey & Commissioner Cline. Abstaining was Commissioner Long. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the following purchase request: Jail to Mentalix Inc. for finger printing machine materials @ \$3465.00 & new ice machine & repair dishwasher @ \$1347.39. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Adult Probation 2014 Financial 4th Quarter Reports and the Juvenile Probation Annual Report. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the Budget Amendments as presented by Drew Lopez, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Drew Lopez, County Auditor also presented the revenue report on the JP offices. Commissioner Long reported that we are down from last year \$22,000.00.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Cline to approve the Department Head recommendations as presented by Teresa Thomas, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the following 14 Right of Ways as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Engineer: 3 to Outrigger Energy LLC on No. County Rd. 21, & 2 on West County Rd 52; 9 to Breitburn Operating: 4 on No. Co. Rd. 15, 2 on No. Co. Rd 17, 1 on No. Co. Rd. 19 &1 Co. Rd. 4D & 1 to Plains Pipeline on E. Howard Field Rd & 1 to Sharp Image Energy on Co. Rd. 17. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Brian Klinksiek, County Engineer presented the Court with a map of the proposed Railroad towers that are required by the Government to be placed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the County & District Clerks to begin charging a Law Library fee in the amount of \$20 per civil case filed in their Courts beginning March 1, 2015 in District Court and April 1, 2015 in County Court. It was requested by the Auditor that we quit collecting this fee in 2013 because the fund was so large, but the law states that they **Shall** charge a Law Library fee and it must be set by Commissioners Court. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Sheriff wanted to let the Court know he was signing an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Federal Bureau of Corrections (FCI). No action was needed.
